It is with deep distress and sadness that I must tell you of the death of our friend and colleague, **Marios Psomas**. He worked for many years as the treasurer for the *Humanist Society of the Suncoast*, and Librarian for the *Matt Cooper Memorial Library*.

He died on Thursday April 4<sup>th</sup> in hospital after a serious heart attack. He was dancing at the time he was stricken, an exercise he loved with notable enthusiasm.

He leaves his wife, Despina, two children, Jasmine and Yannis and 5 grandchildren. Marios' grandchildren were the #1 priority in his life: Alexander, Ares, Achilles, and Apollo were Jasmine's children, and he adored Yannis' first child, baby Dominic Alexander.
